Women Ministry Leadership Thursdays, June 13-27; July 11-25, 7-8:30 pm This cohort is for women who lead or feel led to lead in women's ministry. We will be going through topics from Rethinking Women's Ministry by Cyndee Ownbey, such as "Shifting Target Audience," "Rethinking the Framework," and "Implementing Change." We also will use resources like podcasts and videos from pastors like Craig Groeschel and Stephanie O'Brien about leadership training and techniques. The book is recommeded, but not required to participate. Other resources will be sent via email.

Safe Sanctuaries/AVA: Women Ministries have promoted and supported the AVA (Advocacy for Victims of Abuse) ministry for 20 years. New training materials were launched in January 2024 with the first training at Midwinter with about 40 participants. This training is for pastors and church leaders to equip them to better support victims of abuse. The next training will be held at Gather on June 25th, 8:30am-5:00pm.
